If we become aware that the patient stops wearing their appliance, they will be referred back for a medical follow up with a final report.

Appliance patients have unlimited access to objective level III Home Sleep Testing and/or Pulse Oximetry to establish optimal calibration. Objective MATRx Plus testing is also available to establish response to therapy. A copy of final reports will always be forwarded to both the prescribing and family physicians. *We do not utilize Home Sleep Testing for any other purpose.*
